PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION INTO AYUSH (BHMS) COURSE UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA SEATS IN PRIVATE UN-AIDED NON-MINORITY HOMEOPATHIC COLLEGES IN THE STATE OF TELANGANA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20

A. Regulations:

- i) The following are the Regulations for admission of students into Management Quota (Category -B and Category -C) AYUSH(BHMS) Course in Private Un – Aided Non – Minority, Homeo College in the state of Telangana for the year 2019-20.
- ii) The candidate should have qualified in NEET UG - 2019 exam by securing marks of cut off score and above.
- iii) NEET UG - 2019 merit ranks shall be the basis for the selection into AYUSH Courses subject to these regulations.
- iv) Total number of seats under Management quota expected for the academic year 2019-20 for AYUSH (BHMS) Courses in Private Homeo Colleges will be notified before counseling. Fee structure is as fixed by the State Government.
- v) In case any new AYUSH(BHMS) Courses seats are permitted by CCH/CCIM in private Homeo colleges affiliated to the University for the Academic Year 2019-20, those seats also will be filled up. NO FURTHER NOTIFICATION WILL BE ISSUED.

B. Eligibility:

- i. Candidates from all over the country are eligible for admission into Management quota seats(Category -B and C) for UG AYUSH(BHMS) Course and as per CCIM/CCH / KNR University of Health Sciences.
- ii) The candidate should have passed Intermediate (10+2 pattern) or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology) / Biotechnology and English.
 - OC candidates should obtain not less than 50% marks in science subjects.
 - BC/SC/ST candidates should obtain not less than 40% marks in science subjects.

- OC PH candidates should obtain not less than 45% marks in science subjects.
- iii) Candidates should have qualified at NEET UG - 2018
- iv) The candidates should secure the following cut-off scores in NEET UG-2018 conducted by CBSE, New Delhi for the year 2019-20.

Category	Qualifying criteria	Cut off score (out of 720)	Remarks
General category	50% percentile	134	Candidates scoring equal or more than this cut off score have been declared as qualified
SC / ST/ BC	40% percentile	107	ST / SC / BC Candidates scoring equal or more than this cut off score have been declared as qualified
Persons with disability	45% percentile	120	OC – PH Candidates scoring equal or more than this cut off score have been declared as qualified

- v) Lower percentage / percentile of marks for SC/ST/BC/PH is only for eligibility purpose and will not be applicable for reservation as there are no reservation quotas for these categories.
- viii) Foreign Students / NRI candidates are eligible for admission into AYUSH Courses under Management Quota Category – C Seats.
- *ix) Candidates who have already applied for Convener Quota Seats in response to this University earlier notification are also eligible for the management quota seats, but they have to apply afresh.
- x) Candidates possessing qualification of the University / Board of an institution outside the Telangana State should submit Eligibility / Equivalence certificate from the Board of Intermediate Education of Telangana, to the effect that the qualification possessed is equivalent to or higher than Intermediate examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education of Telangana at the time of admission into the college.
- xi) Candidates possessing qualification of the University / Board of an institution outside INDIA should submit Eligibility / Equivalence certificate issued by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi and Eligibility / Equivalence certificate issued from the Board of

Intermediate Education of Telangana to the effect that the qualification possessed is equivalent to or higher than Intermediate examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education of Telangana at the time of admission into the college.

- xii) The probable number of seats under management quota is given in the Annexure appended herewith, for information.

C. AGE: The candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31-12-2019. The candidates who do not complete 17 years as on 31-12-2019 need not attend the counseling. The candidates born on or after 02-01-2003 are not eligible for admission into BHMS Course. candidates should have not completed 25 years on 31-12-2019 for being eligible for admission.

D. Counselling for allotment of Seats:

- i. The seats shall be filled through online counseling by the Committee for Admissions as per merit from the candidates who have qualified in NEET UG – 2019 exam and applied in response to notification by KNR UHS for Management quota seats (B&C Categories).
- ii. The Date, Time and Venue of online Counselling will be notified by the Committee for Admissions on KNR UHS web-site.
- iii. The candidate along with parent shall be present when called in the order of rank/merit.
- iv. If a candidate fails to be present he will be declared absent and the next candidate in the merit will be considered.
- v. The candidates shall attend the counseling in person along with one of parent.
- vi. The candidates shall attend with all Original Certificates and DD towards University Fee. Custodian certificate will not be permitted.
- vii. Candidates who fail to produce or to submit original certificates or DD for university fee will not be considered for counseling. Such Candidates will be declared absent and the next candidate in the merit will be considered.
- viii. If a candidate after admission in to a College wants to withdraw from the

course, before commencement of second counseling he / she should obtain "No Objection Certificate from the Principal of the college concerned and shall submit the same to the convener, committee of admissions for cancellation of seat. Approval of committee is mandatory for candidate to withdraw from the course.

- ix. Vacant seats after first round of counseling will be filled up in subsequent round of counseling. The Date, Time and Venue of Counseling will be notified by the Committee for Admissions on KNR UHS web-site.
- x. Candidates are hereby informed that they have to join the course by submission of all Original Certificates to the Principal.

E. Penal action :

- i. If the candidate withdraws from the course after Closure of Admission of Management Quota Seats to a College, he /she will forfeit the tuition fee paid for that academic year and has to pay the tuition fee for the rest of the course, along with discontinuation fee of Rs. 1-Lakh to University as mentioned in G.O.170 HM&FW(E1) Dept. Dated:19-9-2017.
- ii. The candidate selected in the final counseling, will not be permitted to cancel the selection. All the selected candidates shall submit an undertaking that he / she will pay the tuition fee for the entire course along with discontinuation fee of Rs. 1-Lakhs to University as mentioned in G.O.170 HM&FW(E1) Dept. Dated:19-9-2017. to avoid wastage of seats, in case withdraws from the college after admission.
- iii. The Original Certificates submitted by the candidates or who withdraws from the Course, before issue of notification for final round of counseling, will be returned.

Fee Structure:

- I. **University Fee :** The selected candidates shall pay non – refundable University fee in the form of crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of “The Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences” payable at Warangal, as given below.

II. Tuition fee: As fixed by the Government of Telangana.

Note -1: The candidates selected against Management Quota Category-B & C Seats shall pay the tuition fee fixed for management Quota seat on the day of reporting in the form of Demand Draft in the name of the Principal of the respective college on the day of admission to the college. If the candidate fails to pay the tuition fee within the time of joining, the admission will be cancelled automatically.

Registration and Processing fee is Rs. 4000/- (Bank transaction charges extra).

Note-2 Candidates are informed that they have to attend for counseling with DD towards university fee on the day of selection/counseling and submit the DD to obtain allotment letter. If the candidate fails to submit the DD for university fee after choosing the seat, the seat will be cancelled automatically without any notice. The candidates will not be given any extension of time to pay the fee. Candidates have to pay the tuition fee at the time of admission at respective colleges. If the candidate fails to pay the tuition fee at the concerned college within stipulated time the admission will be cancelled automatically.

The selected candidates shall submit bank guarantee for remaining period of study.

III. On-line Application Form :

The On-line Application Form for determining merit position in respective categories for management quota seats using NEET UG – 2018 scores will be available on the website <http://knuhs.in/> <http://knuhs.telangana.gov.in/> and <https://tsbhsmmq.tsche.in> from 9.00 AM on 05.09.2019 up to 5.00 PM on 11.09.2019.

The candidate should fill the online application form available in the Website with the data required-for, through internet. The online application form can be filled through any computer with internet connection (home/internet cafe/net center). The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates ready to enter his/her correct data.

IV. Procedure of filling online application and Procedure for online payment:

1. The candidates are advised to take a print out of the Prospectus / Instructions to fill the Application from the website <http://knruhs.in/> <http://knruhs.telangana.gov.in/> and <https://tsbhmsmq.tsche.in> before proceeding to fill the application form.
2. Read the Notification, Prospectus / Regulations carefully.
3. Visit website <https://tsbhmsmq.tsche.in> through Internet Explorer 11 version only to fill the application form.
4. keep all the following documents required:
 - NEET – UG 2019 Admit card issued by the CBSE.
 - NEET – UG 2019 Score card issued by the CBSE.
 - Date of Birth Certificate. (SSC or its equivalent certificate).
 - Credit card / Debit card.
5. The fee can be paid through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking.
6. The fee paid by the applicants is not refundable and not adjusted to a future date under any circumstances.
7. The candidate should sign at the declaration area in the print out of the online application form.
8. The candidate should paste a passport size photograph which is similar to that applied for NEET-UG 2019 in the space provided in the print out of online application form and submit at the time of original certificates verification and Counselling.
9. The candidate should submit the print-out of the filled - in online application form along with one set of attested copies of required certificates at Prof. Ramreddy centre for distance education, O.U. Campus, Hyderabad. (PGRRCCDE) _at the time of original certificates verification and counseling.
10. The candidature of the applicant will not be considered for admission to BHMS Course unless the print-out application form along with the requisite enclosures is submitted at the time of verification of original certificates and counseling.

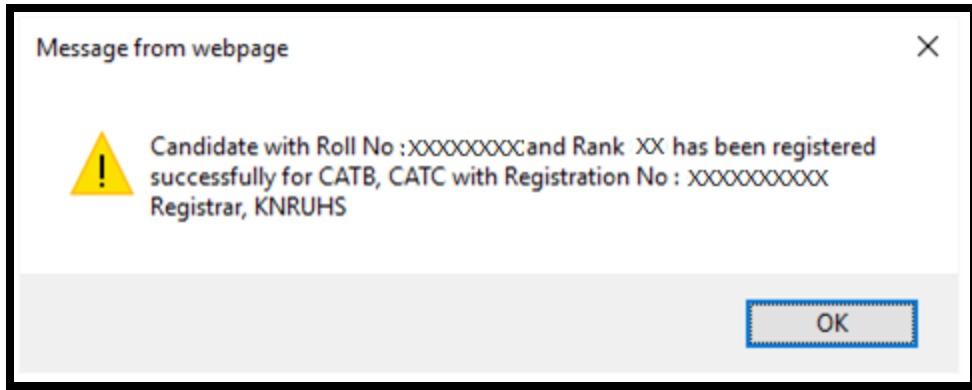

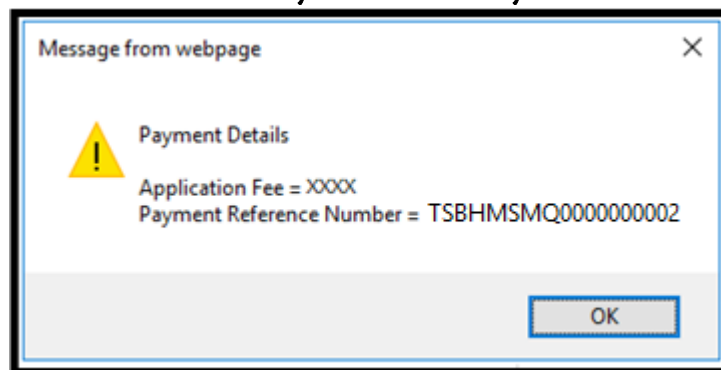

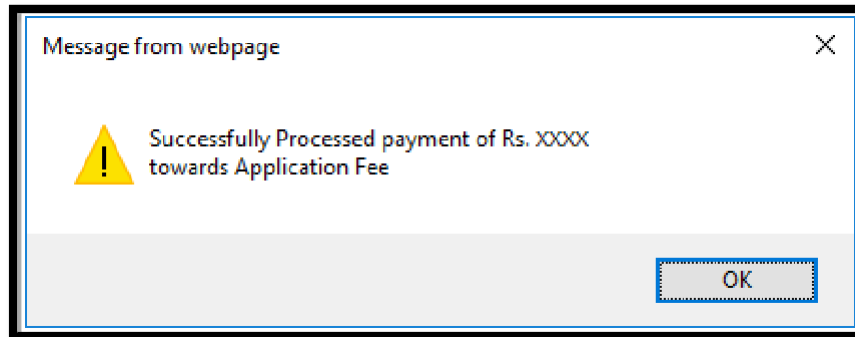

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES ABOUT COUNSELING FOR BHMS COURSE .

The candidates shall attend the counselling with the following original certificates

- (1) Original NEET – UG 2019 Admit card issued by the CBSE
- (2) Original NEET – UG 2019 Score card issued by the CBSE
- (3) SSC certificate or Equivalent Examination showing the Date of Birth of the Candidate.
- (4) Intermediate or its equivalent examination with 10+2 pattern.
- (5) Permanent Caste Certificate, if applicable.(For cutoff score eligibility)
- (6) Differently abled (PH) Certificate, if applicable.(for cutoff score eligibility)

(7) The candidates are advised to visit the website i.e., <http://knruhs.in> for further details such as cut off scores in the NEET, Submission of Marks List of Qualifying Examination, Merit List and Counselling Schedule etc.

(8) As the number of seats available for admission are limited and there will be more number of applicants, it may not be possible to process and allot seats to all the candidates during counseling. Candidates will be allowed for counseling as per their rank in the provisional merit list of KNR UHS based on applied candidates NEET ranks. Once the seats are filled up the remaining candidates will not be permitted in to the counseling hall.
